== Background ==

Bravo Company

The unit's history dates back to World War II where it fought in numerous campaigns in the Pacific War including Guadalcanal, Tarawa, Saipan, Tinian and Okinawa. During the Cold War, it was part of Operation Blue Bat in Lebanon in 1958, the Cuban Missile Crisis in 1962, the intervention in the Dominican Republic in 1965, and the 1983 Beirut barracks bombing in Lebanon where 241 Marines, sailors and soldiers lost their lives. In 1991, it took part in operations during the Gulf War. Since 2001, 1/8 has fought the Global War on Terrorism by serving numerous tours in Iraq and Afghanistan as part of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom - Afghanistan.

After World War II, the division spent a brief period in reserve before being activated as one of the Army's training divisions. Since then, the division's structure has changed several times to adapt to new training roles—for example, by activating regimental and brigade commands or by having subordinate units assigned to or removed from its command.

Since 2014, the brigade has been integrated into the Rapid Forces Division (German: Division Schnelle Kräfte) of the German Army. When the 11th Airmobile Brigade operates integrally with the Defence Helicopter Command (Dutch: Defensie Helikopter Commando) of the Royal Netherlands Air Force they form the 11th Air Manoeuvre Brigade (11 AMB). In 2003 in Poland (exercise Gainful Sword), 2012 in the Netherlands (exercise Peregrine Sword) and 2014 in Hungary the brigade completed its operational readiness tests to (re)apply for the "Air Assault" status. The successful qualifications demonstrated the ability to conduct a brigade-sized operation as 11 AMB.

The 95th was activated too late to deploy for World War I, but remained in the Army's reserve until World War II, when it was sent to Europe. The division became known for repelling fierce German counterattacks and in 1944 was nicknamed the "Iron Men of Metz" for liberating and defending the town. In April 1945, the 95th discovered a German prison and civilian labor camp in the town of Werl.

Operation Phou Phiang II A new radar bombing program by F-111 Aardvarks and B-52 Stratofortresses failed to cripple the Communist forces. On 18 August, Task Force Alpha renewed its offensive moves. It was an attempt to relieve the siege on the guerrilla headquarters at Long Tieng on the Plain of Jars. Air superiority was used to direct over 100 air strike sorties daily to support the offense, and air mobility to shuffle attacking troops. Designed to overwhelm Communist defenses with its multiplicity, the five Lao task forces were defeated in detail by the Communists despite two new columns being improvised and introduced into the fray. It was designed as a two phase attack consisting of five task forces of Thai mercenaries and Royalist guerrillas upon the People's Army of Vietnam invading Laos. Other than securing some high ground near Operation Phou Phiang II (6 August - 25 October 1972) was one of the final battles of the Laotian Civil War. into a defense of the positions already held by Alpha 8dc7f4db97

LO features encompass the geometric stealth shaping of the aircraft, often using a lambda wing or trapezoidal wing, and radiation-absorbent material. Active emitters consist of low-probability-of-intercept radars, radios and laser designators.
