Students normally begin studying the syllabus at the beginning of Year 10 and take the test at the end of Year 11. Traditionally, Pearson Edexcel and especially Cambridge have a dominance in International GCSEs. However, in some international schools, students can begin studying the syllabus at the beginning of Year 9 and take the test at the end of Year 10. The QAA also regulates science education for some qualifications that are not university degrees via various qualification boards, but not content for GCSEs, and GCE AS and A levels. Below university level, science education is the responsibility of three bodies: the Department for Education, Ofqual and the QAA, but at university level, science education is regulated by various professional bodies, and the Bologna Process via the QAA. school league tables.
