United States obscenity law Federal law also bans broadcasting (but not cable or satellite transmission) of "indecent" material during specified hours. Most obscenity cases in the United States obscenity law deals with the regulation or suppression of what is considered obscenity and therefore not protected speech or expression under the First Amendment to the United States Constitution. Federal statutes ban obscenity and child pornography produced with real children (such child pornography is unprotected by the First Amendment even when it is not obscene). State laws operate only within the jurisdiction of each state, and state laws on obscenity differ. In the United States, discussion of obscenity typically relates to defining what pornography is obscene. Issues of obscenity arise at federal and state levels. United States antitrust law antitrust statutes are the Sherman Act of 1890, the Clayton Act of 1914, and the Federal Trade Commission Act of 1914. Section 1 of the Sherman Act prohibits price fixing and the operation of cartels, and prohibits other collusive practices that unreasonably restrain trade. The Robinson-Patman Act, an amendment to the Clayton Act, prohibits price discrimination. S. Apollo Theater The theater was sold in 1949 to the Harlem The Apollo Theater (formerly the Hurtig & Seamon's New Theatre; also Apollo Theatre or 125th Street Apollo Theatre) is a multi-use theater at 253 West 125th Street in the Harlem neighborhood of Upper Manhattan in New York City. The theater, which has approximately 1,500 seats across three levels, was designed by George Keister with elements of the neoclassical style. The nonprofit Apollo Theater Foundation (ATF) operates the theater and a recording studio at the Apollo Theater, as well as two smaller auditoriums

at the Victoria Theater. announced plans to widen the theater and add an air-cooling system when construction materials became available. It is a popular venue for Black American performers and is the home of the TV show Showtime at the Apollo. Moscow theater hostage crisis The Moscow theater hostage crisis, also known as the 2002 Nord-Ost siege, was the seizure of the crowded Dubrovka Theater in Moscow by Chechen terrorists The Moscow theater hostage crisis, also known as the 2002 Nord-Ost siege, was the seizure of the crowded Dubrovka Theater in Moscow by Chechen terrorists on 23 October 2002, resulting in the taking of 912 hostages. They demanded the withdrawal of Russian forces from Chechnya and an end to the Second Chechen War. 132 hostages died, largely due to the effects of the gas. The crisis was resolved when Russian security services released sleeping gas into the building, and subsequently stormed it, killing all 40 hostage takers. The attackers, led by Movsar Barayev, claimed allegiance to the Islamist separatist movement in Chechnya c5e7ec2b84

Rabe v. Washington application of obscenity laws and criminal procedure to the states. The Supreme Court reversed the conviction holding that the citizens of Washington had no notice under the Sixth Amendment that the place where a film was shown was an element of the offense. On 29 August 1968, William Rabe, the manager of a drive-in movie theater in Richland, Washington, was arrested on obscenity charges for showing the film Carmen, Baby. Washington, 405 U. 313 (1972), was a decision by the United States Supreme Court involving the application of obscenity laws and criminal procedure to the states. On 29 August 1968, William Rabe, the manager of a drive-in movie theater in Richland, Washington Rabe v.
