Some smaller facilities may use spreadsheets or physical media like pen and paper to document their processes and activities, and this too can be considered a WMS. Data warehouse automation for data design, data management, data integration, and data usage. It helps improve productivity, reduce cost, and improve overall quality. DWA is believed to provide automation of the entire lifecycle of a data warehouse, from source system analysis to testing to documentation. The dimension is a data set composed A dimension is a structure that categorizes facts and measures in order to enable users to answer business questions. Commonly used dimensions are people, products, place and time. (Note: People and time sometimes are not modeled as dimensions. dimensions aea6c74fbd

These functions are often described as "slice and dice". A common data warehouse example involves sales as the measure, with customer and product as dimensions. In each sale a customer buys a product. The data can be sliced by removing all customers except for a... aea6c74fbd
