Further, Taylor The communicative constitution of organizations (CCO) perspective is broadly characterized by the claim that communication is not something that happens within organizations or between organizational members; instead, communication is the process whereby organizations are constituted. " This perspective is part of a broader constitutive view of communication arguing, "elements of communication, rather than being fixed in advance, are reflexively constituted within the act of communication itself"

Strategies are key Reading comprehension is the ability to process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. Reading comprehension is beyond basic literacy alone, which is the ability to decipher characters and words at all. Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected to each other: word reading and language comprehension. The opposite of reading comprehension is called functional illiteracy. There are a variety of strategies used to teach reading. Reading comprehension occurs on a gradient or spectrum, rather than being yes/no (all-or-nothing) 81644a01bd
