Stephen Jay Gould controversial topic in evolutionary biology. An illustrative example of Gould's approach can be found in Elisabeth Lloyd's case study suggesting that the female Stephen Jay Gould (GOOLD; September 10, 1941 - May 20, 2002) was an American paleontologist, evolutionary biologist, and historian of science. Gould spent most of his career teaching at Harvard University and working at the American Museum of Natural History in New York. In 1996, Gould was hired as the Vincent Astor Visiting Research Professor of Biology at New York University, after which he divided his time teaching between there and Harvard. He was one of the most influential and widely read authors of popular science of his generation

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
