Science Modern science is typically divided into two - or three - major branches: the natural sciences, which study the physical world, and the social sciences, which study individuals and societies. professional features of science began to take shape, along with the changing of "natural philosophy" to "natural science". While referred to as the formal sciences, the study of logic, mathematics, and theoretical computer science are typically regarded as separate because they rely on deductive reasoning instead of the scientific method as their main methodology. Meanwhile, applied sciences are disciplines that use scientific knowledge for practical purposes, such as engineering and medicine.
