It has been noted that in many industrial sectors there are numerous companies with different sizes and organizational In microeconomics, economies of scale are the cost advantages that enterprises obtain due to their scale of operation, and are typically measured by the amount of output produced per unit of cost (production cost). The basis of economies of scale may be technical, statistical, organizational or related factors to the degree of market control. A decrease in cost per unit of output enables an increase in scale that is, increased production with lowered cost 6a20e49cd8

Not all innovations are disruptive, even if they are revolutionary. For example, the first automobiles in the late 19th century were not a disruptive innovation, because early automobiles were expensive luxury items that did not disrupt the market for horse-drawn vehicles. The name difference engine is derived from the method of finite differences, a way to interpolate or tabulate functions by using a small set of polynomial co-efficients. Some of the most common mathematical functions used in engineering, science and navigation are built from logarithmic and trigonometric functions, which can be approximated by polynomials, so a difference engine can compute many useful tables 6a20e49cd8
