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Bell's theorem The first such result was introduced by John Stewart Bell in 1964, building upon the Einstein-Podolsky-Rosen paradox, which had called attention to the phenomenon of quantum entanglement. Lagrangian mechanics Newton's laws and the concept of forces are In physics, Lagrangian mechanics is an alternate formulation of classical mechanics founded on the

d'Alembert principle of virtual work. Lagrange's approach greatly simplifies the analysis of many problems in mechanics, and it had crucial influence on other branches of physics, including relativity and quantum field theory. This constraint allows the calculation of the equations of motion of the system using Lagrange's equations. It was introduced by the Italian-French mathematician and astronomer Joseph-Louis Lagrange in his presentation to the Turin Academy of Science in 1760 culminating in his 1788 grand opus, *Mécanique analytique*

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
