Comparison of analog and digital recording Musicians and listeners have argued over the superiority of digital versus analog sound recordings. Arguments for analog systems include the absence of fundamental error mechanisms which are present in digital audio systems, including aliasing and associated anti-aliasing filter implementation, jitter and quantization noise. Both techniques introduce errors and distortions in the sound, and these methods can be systematically compared.
