The engine technology and layout was a descendant of Honda's racing V4 machines, such as the NS750 and NR750. The V45's performance is comparable to that of Valkyries and Honda's 1800 cc V-twin cruisers. The styling of the original Supra was derived from the Toyota Celica, but it was longer. Starting in mid-1986, the A70 Supra became a separate model from the Celica. In turn, Toyota also stopped using the prefix Celica and named the car Supra. Owing to the similarity and past of the Celica's name, it is frequently mistaken for the Supra, and vice versa.
