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Surface-supplied diving publishes info note on divers' gas supply. It is also nearly impossible for the diver to get lost. The primary advantages of conventional surface supplied diving are lower risk of drowning and considerably larger breathing gas supply than scuba, allowing longer working periods and safer decompression. Aqueduct (bridge) The word is derived from the Latin aqua ("water") and ducere ("to lead"), therefore meaning "to lead water". Aqueducts must span a crossing at the same level as the watercourses on each end. They may take the form of tunnels, networks of surface channels and canals, covered clay pipes or monumental bridges. The term aqueduct may also be used to refer to the entire watercourse, as well as the bridge. Large navigable aqueducts are used as transport links for boats or ships. A modern version of an aqueduct is a pipeline bridge.
