Hafnium is named after Hafnia, the Latin name for Copenhagen, where it was discovered. Promethium Laboratory in 1945 by the separation and analysis of the fission products of uranium fuel irradiated in a graphite reactor. Chemically, promethium is a lanthanide. Promethium is one of the only two radioactive elements that are both preceded and followed in the periodic table by elements with stable forms, the other being technetium. All of its isotopes are radioactive; it is extremely rare, with only about 500-600 grams naturally occurring in the Earth's crust at any given time. An intermediate step was considered prudent.
