The political line pursued by Buttiglione, however, was harshly opposed by leading members of the CDU: the Lombard president Roberto Formigoni and the Apulian exponent Raffaele Fitto. The movement also played the crucial role of spreading information and raising awareness among international public opinion, unveiling the reality of fascist Italy which was hidden behind regime propaganda, in particular thanks to the actions of Gaetano Salvemini, who had been the inspiration behind the group and the teacher of Rosselli. The election of 1948 was perhaps the most important in the history of the Italian Republic, as the choice of future alliance with the United States or with the Soviet Union was at issue.
