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Resnais' first feature-length work, it was a co-production between France and Japan, and documents a series of intensely personal conversations (or one long conversation) over slightly more than a 24-hour period between an unnamed French actress and a Japanese architect. The film is notable for Resnais' innovative use of brief flashbacks to suggest flashes of memory, which create a nonlinear storyline.
a34c1b0b35 Resnais began making feature films in the late 1950s and consolidated his early reputation with *Hiroshima mon amour* (1959), *Last Year at Marienbad* (1961), and *Muriel* (1963), all of which adopted unconventional narrative techniques to deal with themes of troubled memory and the imagined past. These films were contemporary with, and associated with, the French New Wave (*la nouvelle vague*), though Resnais did not regard himself as being fully part of that movement...
