Global aphasia Acquired impairments of communicative abilities are present across all language modalities, impacting language production, comprehension, and repetition. Patients with global aphasia may be able to verbalize a few short utterances and use non-word neologisms, but their overall production ability is limited. Due to the preservation of the right hemisphere, an individual with global aphasia may still be able to express themselves through facial expressions, gestures, and intonation. Their ability to repeat words, utterances, or phrases is also affected. Mixed transcortical aphasia Broca's, Wernicke's, and the arcuate fasciculus are left intact; however, they are isolated from other brain regions. neurogenic cognitive-communicative disorder which presents with impaired comprehension and production of speech and language, usually caused by damage in the Mixed transcortical aphasia is the least common of the three transcortical aphasias (behind transcortical motor aphasia and transcortical sensory aphasia, respectively). This type of aphasia can also be referred to as "Isolation Aphasia". This type of aphasia is a result of damage that isolates the language areas (Broca's, Wernicke’s, and the arcuate fasciculus) from other brain regions 803c5795b7

Memory span Backward memory span is a more challenging variation which involves recalling items in reverse order.
