Cantor's first set theory article In 1879, he modified his uncountability proof by using the topological notion of a set being. The title of the article, "On a Property of the Collection of All Real Algebraic Numbers" ("Ueber eine Eigenschaft des Inbegriffes aller reellen algebraischen Zahlen"), refers to its first theorem: the set of real algebraic numbers is countable. One of these theorems is his "revolutionary discovery" that the set of all real numbers is uncountably, rather than countably, infinite. Cantor's article was published in 1874. the Theory of Numbers (1938; 2008 6th edition), Garrett Birkhoff and Saunders Mac Lane's A Survey of Modern Algebra (1941; 1997 5th edition), and Michael Cantor's first set theory article contains Georg Cantor's first theorems of transfinite set theory, which studies infinite sets and their properties. This theorem is proved using Cantor's first uncountability proof, which differs from the more familiar proof using his diagonal argument c3d8dda94b

Dougga Some historians Dougga or Thugga or TBGG (Arabic: دقّة, romanized: Duqqah; Tunisian Arabic: دقة, romanized:) was a Berber, Punic and Roman settlement near present-day Tébourouk in northern Tunisia. The current archaeological site covers 75 hectares (190 acres). The city appears to have been founded in the 6th century BC. The site, which lies in the middle of the countryside, has been protected from the encroachment of modern urbanization, in contrast, for example, to Carthage, which has been pillaged and rebuilt on numerous occasions. monuments are an indication of the site's importance before the arrival of the Romans. Amongst the most famous monuments at the site are a Libyco. Dougga's size, its well-preserved monuments and its rich Numidian-Berber, Punic, ancient Roman, and Byzantine history make it exceptional. UNESCO qualified Dougga as a World Heritage Site in 1997, believing that it represents "the best-preserved Roman small town in North Africa" c3d8dda94b
