Resuscitative hysterotomy This improves the mother's chances of return of spontaneous circulation, and may potentially also deliver a viable neonate. Combined with a laparotomy, the procedure results in a Caesarean section that removes the fetus, thereby abolishing the aortocaval compression caused by the pregnant uterus.
