United Nations Development Programme The UNDP emphasizes on developing local capacity towards long-term self-sufficiency and prosperity. Conflicts or disasters, and promote early recovery after crisis have occurred. UNDP works through its country offices to support local government in needs assessment. The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) is a United Nations agency tasked with helping countries eliminate poverty and achieve sustainable economic growth and human development.

Capacity building The United Nations Development Programme defines itself by "capacity development" in the sense of "how UNDP works" to fulfill its mission. The UN system applies it in almost every sector, including. Since the 1950s, international organizations, governments, non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and communities use the concept of capacity building as part of "social and economic development" in national and subnational plans. The terms capacity building and capacity development have often been used interchangeably, although a publication by OECD-DAC stated in 2006 that capacity development was the preferable term. The UN system applies it in almost every sector, including several. Capacity building (or capacity development, capacity strengthening) is the improvement in an individual's or organization's facility (or capability) "to produce, perform or deploy". itself by "capacity development"; in the sense of "how UNDP works" to fulfill its mission.

Disaster response This is particularly so in countries where the government does not. Disaster response refers to the actions taken directly before, during, or immediately after a disaster. Humanitarian organisations are often present in this phase of the disaster management cycle. Or it can involve establishing semi-permanent settlements in camps and other locations. It includes warning and evacuation, search and rescue, providing immediate assistance, assessing damage, continuing assistance, and the immediate restoration or construction of infrastructure. An example of this would be building provisional storm drains or diversion dams. The objective is to save lives, ensure health and safety, and meet the subsistence needs of the people affected. It can involve specific but limited aid, such as helping refugees with transport, temporary shelter, and food. Emergency response aims to provide immediate help to keep people alive, improve their health and support their morale.
