NoSQL Unlike relational databases, which organize data into rows and columns like a spreadsheet, NoSQL databases use a single data structure—such as key-value pairs, wide columns, graphs, or documents—to hold information. NoSQL systems are sometimes called "Not only SQL" because they can support SQL-like query languages or work alongside SQL databases in polyglot-persistent setups, where multiple database types are combined. If an excessive number of queries would NoSQL (originally meaning "Not only SQL" or "non-relational") refers to a type of database design that stores and retrieves data differently from the traditional table-based structure of relational databases. Since this non-relational design does not require a fixed schema, it scales easily to manage large, often unstructured datasets. Non-relational databases date back to the. NoSQL queries are often faster than traditional SQL queries, so the cost of additional queries may be acceptable
