There is no standard definition of a metalloid and no complete agreement on which elements are metalloids. The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oeidēs

In US and many international publications, BAC levels are written as a percentage such as 0.08%, i.e. there is 0.8 grams of alcohol per liter of blood. In different countries, the maximum permitted BAC when driving ranges from the limit of detection (zero tolerance) to 0.08% (0.8 g/L).
