Apollonius of Perga The equivalence of two descriptions of planet motions, one using Apollonius of Perga (Ancient Greek: Ἀπολλώνιος ὁ Περγαῖος Apollōnios ho Pergaios; c. 190 BC) was an ancient Greek geometer and astronomer known for his work on conic sections.

Beginning from the earlier contributions of Euclid and Archimedes on the topic, he brought them to the state prior to the invention of analytic geometry. Geometric methods in the golden age could produce most of the results of elementary algebra. 240 BC – c. His definitions of the terms ellipse, parabola, and hyperbola are the ones in use today.
