This course is equivalent to a one semester, non-calculus-based introductory college

Mathematics education in the United States With the adoption of the Common Core Standards in most states and the District of Columbia beginning in 2010, mathematics content across the country has moved into closer agreement for each grade level. The SAT, a standardized university entrance exam, has been reformed to better reflect the contents of the Common Core. Placement testing The goal is to offer low-scoring students remedial coursework (or other remediation) to prepare them for regular coursework. Since most two-year colleges have open, non-competitive admissions policies, many students are admitted without college-level academic qualifications. Placement exams or placement tests assess abilities in English, mathematics and reading; they may also be used in other disciplines such as foreign languages, computer and internet technologies, health and natural sciences. gatekeeper college courses such as Expository Writing or College Algebra.
