Sex trafficking “domestic minor sex trafficking”. Every aspect of sex trafficking is considered a crime, from acquisition to transportation and exploitation of victims. Sex traffickers use force, fraud, and coercion as they recruit, transport, and provide their victims as prostitutes. Sometimes victims are brought into a situation of dependency on their trafficker(s), financially or emotionally. Perpetrators of the crime are called sex traffickers or pimps—people who manipulate victims to engage in various forms of commercial sex with paying customers. It has been called a form of modern slavery because of the way victims are forced. Commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC) is defined as “encompassing several forms of exploitation, including pornography Sex trafficking is human trafficking for the purpose of sexual exploitation. This includes any sexual exploitation of adults or minors, including child sex tourism (CST) and domestic minor sex trafficking (DMST)

Illegal adoptions violate multiple child rights norms and principles, including the best interests of the child, the principle of subsidiarity and the prohibition of improper financial gain 7f0c7fd7f9

Many historical cases of enslavement occurred as a result of breaking the law, becoming indebted, suffering a military defeat, or exploitation for cheaper labor; other forms of slavery were instituted along demographic lines such as race or sex.
