The first-generation Lacetti was available as a four-door sedan and five-door station wagon, styled by Pininfarina—and five-door hatchback styled by Giorgetto Giugiaro. In addition to handling and performance upgrades, T-Type vehicles were distinguished by exterior styling, with chrome trim reduced or blacked out altogether and some models featuring two-tone paintwork; all vehicles were fitted with aluminum wheels. From 2008 to 2011, the Buick Super name was revived as a flagship trim, bringing a V8 engine to the Buick LaCrosse and Buick Lucerne sedans; while T-Type was the performance marker used on Buick automobiles during the 1980s 4e9bb32b82
