In this definition, lab-on-a-chip devices do not strictly have biological applications, although most do or are amenable to be adapted for biological purposes. (2016). Radio-frequency identification ICAO refers to the ISO/IEC 14443 RFID chips in e-passports as "contactless integrated circuits". Volumes 1 and 2 (6th edition, 2006). An RFID system consists of a tiny radio transponder called a tag, a radio receiver, and a transmitter. ICAO standards provide Radio-frequency identification (RFID) uses electromagnetic fields to automatically identify and track tags attached to objects. When triggered by an electromagnetic interrogation pulse from a nearby RFID reader device, the tag transmits digital data, usually an identifying inventory number, back to the reader. This number can be used to track inventory goods 7d13e2e029

Unlike a barcode, the tag does not need to be within the line of sight of the reader, so it may be embedded in the tracked object... 7d13e2e029 Passive tags are powered by energy from the RFID reader's interrogating radio waves. Active tags are powered by a battery and thus can be read at a greater range from the RFID reader, up to hundreds of meters. 7d13e2e029

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
