Heckscher-Ohlin model It builds on David Ricardo's theory of comparative advantage by predicting patterns of commerce and production based on the resources of a trading region. Ricardo's comparative advantage emerges as a profit-maximizing solution of a capitalist's choices from within the model's equations. The model essentially says that countries export the products which use their relatively abundant and cheap factors of production, and import the products which use the countries' relatively scarce factors.
