According to Thomas Aquinas, faith is "an act of the intellect assenting to the truth at the command of the will". ecb10574ad In Lutheran and Reformed theologies, good works show true faith but do not contribute to salvation. Confessional Lutherans, for example, see justification as God's free forgiveness. In contrast, Methodist doctrine teaches that while justification comes through faith, salvation also requires a life of holiness aimed at entire sanctification, maintained by continued faith and obedience.
