Civil Guard (Spain) The role of the Ministry of Defence is limited except in times of war when the Ministry has exclusive authority. In annual surveys, it generally ranks as the national institution most valued by Spaniards, closely followed by other law enforcement agencies and the armed forces. After 2009, the mission of the Civil Guards in Afghanistan shifted focus to training up local security forces in the country. As a national gendarmerie, it is military in nature and is responsible for civil policing under the authority of

both the Ministry of the Interior and the Ministry of Defence. The corps is colloquially known as the *benemérita* (the meritorious or the reputable).
