The quantity of analyte extracted by the fibre is proportional to its concentration in the sample as long as equilibrium is reached or, in case of short time pre-equilibrium, with help of convection or agitation 69708ef246

EI is the most useful for organic compounds which have a molecular weight below 600 amu. This leads to extensive fragmentation, which can be helpful for structure determination of unknown compounds.
