grandfather was a physics professor. His mother worked in a biochemistry laboratory and her father was a biochemistry professor. The novel belongs to the Dying Earth subgenre. It is rooted in hard science fiction, but also incorporates several other genres, including fantasy and horror. Bear called it science fiction "stretched to the nth degree". He said that in the novel he honors those writers who changed the face of science fiction and fantasy, including William Hope Hodgson and Arthur C. Clarke, and pays homage to Hodgson's 1912 novel, *The Night Land*, with which *City at the End of Time* shares a number of plot elements.

He won numerous awards over the course of his career. His most awarded novel was *Moving Mars*, which won a Nebula Award. His last work was the 2021 novel *The Unfinished Land*. Greg Bear wrote over 50 books in total. He was one of the five co-founders of San Diego Comic-Con.

The novel received a mixed reception from critics. Some reviewers were impressed by the novel's scope and grandiosity, while others felt that the characters were underdeveloped and the story was difficult...

Stephenson's work explores mathematics, cryptography, linguistics, philosophy, currency, and the history of science. He also writes nonfiction articles about technology in publications such as *Wired*. He has written novels with his uncle, George Jewsbury ("J. Frederick George"), under the collective pseudonym Stephen Bury.
