Motörhead were originally formed in 1975 in London by bassist and vocalist Ian "Lemmy" Kilmister, after his departure from Hawkwind, who drafted in guitarist Larry Wallis and drummer Lucas Fox (who was quickly replaced by Phil "Philthy Animal" Taylor) to complete the band's initial lineup. In 1978, Motörhead signed with Bronze Records; their first releases on the label was Overkill and Bomber, both in 1979. The trio recorded their debut album for release on United Artists, although it was not released until 1979 as On Parole. on the UK Albums Chart.
