Like all gay and lesbian periodicals, it was banned. Die Freundin (German pronunciation: [di: 'fʁɔɪndɪn], "The Girlfriend") was a popular Weimar-era German lesbian magazine published from 1924 to 1933. On 8 March 1933, the last issue of Die Freundin was published as the 10th edition of the 9th year.
