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Dodge Ram Van The B series replaced the forward control Dodge A100, transitioning to a front-engine, rear-wheel-drive layout that shared components with The Dodge Ram Van (originally the Dodge B series) is a range of full-size vans that were produced by Chrysler Corporation from the 1971 to 2003 model years. model years.
