Mistakes were made The speaker "Mistakes were made" is an expression that is commonly used as a rhetorical device,

whereby a speaker acknowledges that a situation was handled poorly or inappropriately but seeks to evade any direct admission or accusation of responsibility. The acknowledgement of "mistakes" is framed in an abstract sense, with no direct reference to who made the mistakes, or the nature and extent of them. The word "mistakes" also does not imply intent.
