Baroque music Baroque music forms a major portion of the "classical music" canon, and continues to be widely studied, performed, and listened to. Overlapping in time, they are conventionally dated from 1580 to 1650, from 1630 to 1700, and from 1680 to 1750. The Baroque style followed the Renaissance period, and was followed in turn by the Classical period after a short transition (the galant style). The term "baroque" comes from the Portuguese word barroco, meaning "misshapen pearl". consistent texture in French music by Robert Ballard, in his lute books of 1611 and 1614, and by Ennemond Gaultier. This idiomatic lute figuration was later transferred Baroque music (UK: or US:) refers to the period or dominant style of Western classical music composed from about 1600 to 1750. Key composers of the Baroque era include Johann Sebastian Bach, Antonio Vivaldi, George Frideric Handel, Georg Philipp. The Baroque period is divided into three major phases: early, middle, and late b782d00b88
