Earthing system Static buildup An earthing system (UK and IEC) or grounding system (US) connects specific parts of an electric power system with the ground, typically the equipment's conductive surface, for safety and functional purposes. Regulations may identify special cases for earthing in mines, in patient care areas, or in hazardous areas of industrial plants. Regulations for earthing systems vary among countries,

though most follow the recommendations of the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC).
