Solar term The solar terms are also used to calculate intercalary months; which month is repeated depends on the position of the sun at the time. lines provides a concise version of the names of the 24 jieqi. The points are spaced 15° apart along the ecliptic and are used by lunisolar calendars to stay synchronized with the seasons, which is crucial for agrarian societies.
