Ammonium chloride It is mainly used as fertilizer and a flavouring agent in some types of liquorice. Solutions of ammonium chloride are mildly acidic. It is a white crystalline salt that is highly soluble in water. It is a product of the reaction of hydrochloric acid and ammonia. It is an ammonium salt of hydrogen chloride. The mineral is commonly formed on burning coal dumps from condensation of coal-derived gases. It consists of ammonium cations $[\text{NH}_4]^+$ and chloride anions Cl^- . temperatures in cooling baths. Ammonium chloride solutions with ammonia are used as buffer solutions including ACK (Ammonium-Chloride-Potassium) lysis Ammonium chloride is an inorganic chemical compound with the chemical formula NH_4Cl , also written as $[\text{NH}_4]\text{Cl}$.
