Akiyuki Tateyama served as the composer for the first season of Laid-Back Camp. He composed the music characterizing the campsites based on photographs shown to him by director Yoshiaki Kyōgoku since the latter wanted the music to match a specific scenery rather than the characters. Tateyama cited acoustic guitar, banjo, and mandolin as one of the instruments he used in composing the soundtracks. == Episodes == For the soundtracks used during the scenes between Rin Shima and her grandfather, Tateyama composed them with the inclusion of bassoon at the end of production when most of the soundtracks had been written. He cited the film Cinema Paradiso (1988) as the influence in composing those soundtracks. For Nadeshiko Kagamihara's theme, he used Royal piano to match her "bright and sparkling" personality. Her two soundtracks ("Nadeshiko" and "Nadeshiko's Thoughts") were built around the four musical notes (do, mi, so, do). The film was included in a project pitched by producer Shōichi Hotta to animation producer Ryoji Maru after accepting it from FuRyu. The film was announced in October 2018, with Kyogoku, Tanaka, Ito, and character designer Mutsumi Sasaki confirming their return from two seasons of Laid-Back Camp in April 2021. Yumiri Hanamori, Nao Tōyama, Sayuri Hara, Aki Toyosaki, and Rie Takahashi were confirmed in October 2021 to be reprising their voice roles from the anime television series, with their characters going to be matured in the film. Additional staff and cast for the film were revealed in March and June 2022, respectively.

== Episodes == An anime television series adaptation by C-Station, aired on AT-X from January to March 2018. A short anime spin-off, titled Room Camp, aired from January to March 2020. A live action drama series aired in Japan from January to March 2020, and a second drama season aired from April to June 2021. A second anime season aired from January to April 2021, and an anime film premiered on July 1, 2022. A virtual reality video game based on the series was released in March 2021, and a visual novel developed by MAGES was released in November

The series debuted on AT-X, with the first season aired from January 4 to March 22, 2018, and consists of 12 episodes. The second season aired from January 7 to April 1, 2021, and consists of 13 episodes. The third season aired from April 4 to June 20, 2024, and consists of 12 episodes. The fourth season will be aired in 2027. The series premiered in Japan on TV Tokyo, TV Osaka, and TV Aichi on January 10, 2020, and concluded on June 18, 2021, with 24 episodes broadcast over two seasons. Ahead of the premiere of the second season is a special program for the series, which was aired on March 29, 2021.
