Body snatching The term was coined primarily in regard to cases in the United Kingdom and United States throughout the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries. The term 'body snatching' most commonly refers to the removal and sale of corpses primarily for the purpose of

dissection or anatomy lectures in medical schools. However, there have been cases of body snatching in many countries, with the first recorded case in Europe dating back to 1319 in Bologna, Italy. arrested after they exhumed dozens of graves from Muslim cemeteries in Burdwan district, and smuggled the skeletons not just to medical institutions in Body snatching is the illicit removal of corpses from graves, morgues, and other burial sites. Body snatching is distinct from the act of grave robbery as grave robbing does not explicitly involve the removal of the corpse, but rather theft from the burial site itself. In 1891, Curzon was named Under-Secretary of State for India, and in 1899 he was appointed Viceroy of India. 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Rabindranath Tagore He reshaped Bengali literature and music as well as Indian art with Contextual Modernism in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. He was a fellow of. He was the author of the "profoundly sensitive, fresh and beautiful" poetry of Gitanjali. Tagore's poetic songs were viewed as spiritual and mercurial; his elegant prose and magical poetry were widely popular in the Indian subcontinent. a village named Kush (in Burdwan zilla) by Maharaja Kshitisura, he became its chief and came to be known as Kushari. 2007 Samjhauta Express bombings Of the 70 fatalities, most were Pakistani civilians. Bombs were set off in two carriages, both filled with passengers, just after the train passed Diwana near the Indian city of Panipat, 80 kilometres (50 mi) north of New Delhi. 70 people were killed in the ensuing fire and dozens more were injured. The victims also included some Indian civilians and three railway policemen. " Questions were raised over a Pakistani national who was arrested after the bombings for not carrying valid papers and was seen as suspicious. The 2007 Samjhauta Express bombings was a terrorist attack that occurred around midnight on 18 February 2007 on the Samjhauta Express, a twice-weekly train service connecting Delhi, India, and Lahore, Pakistan. Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 Additionally, the act excludes 58,000 Sri Lankan Tamil refugees, who have

lived in India since the 1980s. as North 24 Parganas, Nadia, Hooghly, Cooch Behar, South Dinajpur, East Burdwan, and other parts of West Bengal. The eligible minorities were stated as Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis or Christians. The community, having immigrated during The Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 (CAA) was passed by the Parliament of India on 11 December 2019. It amended the Citizenship Act, 1955 by providing an accelerated pathway to Indian citizenship for persecuted refugees of religious minorities from Islamic countries Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who arrived in India by 2014. The law does not grant such eligibility to Muslims from these Islamic countries. The act was the first time that religion had been overtly used as a criterion for citizenship under Indian law, and it attracted global criticism 8c3a7f0f9d
