Autonomous diver contents. Most training organizations do not recommend exceeding a depth of 18 or 20 meters at this level of certification. Various organizations offer training that meets the requirements of the Autonomous Diver standard. It describes the minimum requirements for basic training and certification for recreational scuba divers in international standard ISO 24801-2 and the equivalent European Standard EN 14153-2. After completion of this certification, the training can be extended to a dive leader to ISO 24801-3 or an intermediate not defined by international standards. The PADI Open Water Diver Course (OWD) is an entry-level diver training programme to the ISO standards for Autonomous Diver. certification agency to allow the newly certified diver to dive within the specified range of conditions.
