Maple syrup Maple trees are tapped by drilling holes into their trunks and collecting the sap, which is heated to evaporate much of the water, leaving the concentrated syrup. Advancements have since been made in tubing and vacuum pumps, filtering techniques, high-efficiency preheaters, and storage containers. In cold climates these trees store starch in their trunks and roots before winter; the starch is then converted to sugar that rises in the sap in late winter and early spring. efficiency. Food preservation By preserving food, food waste can be reduced, which is an important way to decrease production costs and increase the efficiency of food systems, improve food security and nutrition and contribute towards environmental sustainability. Food preservation may also include processes that inhibit visual deterioration, such as the enzymatic browning reaction in apples after they are cut during food preparation. Vacuum-packing stores food in a vacuum environment, usually in an air-tight bag or bottle 148ed1d2ee

Modified atmosphere Oxygen scavengers may also be used to. In food, oxygen is readily available for lipid oxidation reactions. Oxygen also helps maintain high respiration rates of fresh produce, which contribute to shortened shelf life. Inside the packaging can be achieved using active techniques, such as gas flushing and compensated vacuum, or passively by designing "breathable" films. From a microbiological aspect, oxygen encourages the growth of aerobic spoilage microorganisms. Modified atmosphere packaging (MAP) is the practice of modifying the composition of the internal atmosphere of a package (commonly food packages, drugs, etc.) in order to improve the shelf life. The need for this technology for food arises from the short shelf life of food products such as meat, fish, poultry, and dairy in the presence of oxygen. Therefore, the reduction of oxygen and its replacement with other gases can reduce or delay oxidation reactions and microbiological spoilage 148ed1d2ee

Toilet They may A toilet is a piece of sanitary hardware that collects human waste (urine and feces) and sometimes toilet paper, usually for disposal. They can be designed for a sitting position popular in Europe and North America with a toilet seat, with additional considerations for those with disabilities, or for a squatting posture more popular in Asia, known as a squat toilet. In urban areas, flush toilets are usually connected to a sewer system; in isolated areas, to a septic tank. Flush toilets use water, while dry or non-flush toilets do not. The waste is known as blackwater and the combined effluent, including other sources, is sewage. Dry toilets are connected to a pit, removable container, composting chamber, or other storage and treatment device, including urine diversion with a urine-diverting. PM processes are sometimes used to reduce or eliminate the need for subtractive processes in manufacturing, lowering material losses and reducing the cost of the final product. They are also used when melting a material is impractical, due to it having a high melting point, or an alloy of two mutually insoluble materials, such as a mixture of copper and graphite. many classifications of these techniques, but they can be divided into two main categories: resistance sintering techniques, which apply lower voltages Powder metallurgy (PM) is a term covering a wide range of ways in which materials or components are made from metal powders 148ed1d2ee

"Sonar" can refer to one of two types of technology: passive sonar means listening for the sound made by vessels; active sonar means emitting pulses of sounds and listening for echoes. Dairy farming Before the 20th century, milking was done by hand on small farms.
