Ruane graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1945 with a degree in electrical engineering and from Harvard Business School in 1949. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy and was on his way to Japan when World War II ended. He met Warren Buffett at an investment seminar with value investing guru Benjamin Graham and he and Buffett became lifelong friends. They both worked as assistants to Graham at Columbia University. For example, if a stock is selling for \$50, but it is worth \$100 based on predictable future cash flows, then it is an undervalued stock.
