Born on 30 April 1926, in Marple, near Stockport, Cheshire, Cooper left school at the age of 15. Genre is the term for any category of creative work, which includes literature and other forms of art or entertainment (e.g. music)—whether written or spoken, audio or visual—based on some set of stylistic criteria. Often, works fit into multiple genres by way of borrowing and recombining these conventions.
