VSD originated within the field of information systems design and human-computer Value sensitive design (VSD) is a theoretically grounded approach to the design of technology that accounts for human values in a principled and comprehensive manner. technology that accounts for human values in a principled and comprehensive manner. VSD originated within the field of information systems design and human-computer interaction to address design issues within the fields by emphasizing the ethical values of direct and indirect stakeholders. Designs are developed using an investigation consisting of three phases: conceptual, empirical and technological. These investigations are intended to be iterative, allowing the designer to modify the design continuously. Value Sensitive Design takes human values into account in a well-defined matter throughout the whole process. It was developed by Batya Friedman and Peter Kahn at the University of Washington starting in the late 1980s and early 1990s
