Forced-air Regardless of type, all air handlers consist of an air filter, blower, heat exchanger/element/coil, and various controls. A commonly used technique to remove pollutants and heat in an indoor environment, cross ventilation can also decrease or even obviate the need for air conditioning and can improve indoor air quality. Ventilation (architecture) When a building design relies on infiltration to maintain indoor air quality, this flow has been referred to as adventitious ventilation. It can also be used to control indoor temperature, humidity, and air motion to benefit thermal comfort, satisfaction with other aspects of the indoor environment, or other objectives. It is typically described as separate from infiltration, the circumstantial flow of air from outdoors to indoors through leaks (unplanned openings) in a building envelope. Ventilation is usually categorized as either mechanical ventilation, natural ventilation, or mixed-mode ventilation. systems to achieve acceptable indoor air quality include the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) Standards 62 Ventilation is the intentional introduction of outdoor air into a space, mainly to control indoor air quality by diluting and displacing indoor effluents and pollutants 9c43ecd505
