Lockout-tagout This prevents accidental startup of equipment while it is in a hazardous state or while a worker is in direct contact with it. The worker then holds the key for the lock, ensuring that only that worker can remove the lock and start the equipment. The isolated power sources are then locked and a tag is placed on the lock identifying the worker and reason the LOTO is placed on it. The SHELL model adopts a systems perspective that suggests the human is rarely, if ever, the sole cause of an accident. The systems perspective considers a variety of contextual and task-related factors that interact with the human operator within the aviation system to affect operator performance.
