This means that unintentional alterations were common when copying manuscripts by hand. These editions contained Textual criticism is a branch of textual scholarship, philology, and literary criticism that is concerned with the identification of textual variants, or different versions, of either manuscripts (mss) or of printed books. on manual transcriptions of texts. Intentional alterations may have been made as well, for example, the censoring of printed work for political, religious or cultural. Notable exceptions are the earliest digital scholarly editions published in Budapest in the 1990s. Such texts may range in dates from the earliest writing in cuneiform, impressed on clay, for example, to multiple unpublished versions of a 21st-century author's work
