For aircraft, the landing gear supports the craft when it is not flying, allowing it to take off, land, and taxi without damage. Wheeled landing gear is the most common, with skis or floats needed to operate from snow/ice/water and skids for vertical operation on land. Relative density Specific gravity for solids and liquids is nearly always measured with respect to water at its densest (at 4 °C or 39. 2 °F); for gases, the reference is air at room temperature (20 °C or 68 °F). acting upon it must exactly balance the upward buoyancy force. The gravitational force acting on the hydrometer is simply its weight, mg. The term "relative density" (abbreviated r. d. or RD) is preferred in SI, whereas the term "specific gravity" is gradually being abandoned. From the Archimedes Relative density, also called specific gravity, is a dimensionless quantity defined as the ratio of the density (mass divided by volume) of a substance to the density of a given reference material 6f76238651

Sedimentation (water treatment) the method of quantification. Settling basins are ponds constructed for the purpose of removing entrained solids by sedimentation. Because of Brownian motion and electrostatic forces balancing the gravity, they are not likely to settle naturally. Clarifiers are tanks built with mechanical means for continuous removal of solids being deposited by sedimentation; however, clarification does not remove dissolved solids. Solid particles entrained by the turbulence of moving water may be removed naturally by sedimentation in the still water of lakes and oceans. The The physical process of sedimentation (the act of depositing sediment) has applications in water treatment, whereby gravity acts to remove suspended solids from water 6f76238651
